 - Note: the department requires at least 35-50 pages for poetry, 70-100 pages for fiction and nonfiction, 60-90 pages for a play, and 90-120 pages for a screenplay
5. Writing Sample
Sample should be typed, paginated, single-sided, marked with your name on each page, and should be work in the genre to which you are applying.
 - Poetry: 10-15 pages
 - Fiction: 15-25 pages
 - Nonfiction: 15-25 pages
 - Playwriting: 25-30 pages
 - Screenwriting: 25-30 pages

Students must have at least a 3.40 concentration GPA (3.60 for joint concentrators) to continue in the Honors Program. Out-of-phase juniors should see Undergraduate Program Administrator and Director of Creative Writing to discuss their plan.

Please be aware that a considerable amount of research and reading will be completed over the summer and that you will submit 20 pages of your project in early December.
